This will help us get to know our interns better and give you the opportunity to participate in a job interview that will hopefully help to serve good learning experiences for future occupational opportunities.

### Our Internship Expectations:

As we seek to serve the Church to God's glory we have high expectations for this challenging and rewarding position:

- Pursue our youth mission and vision statements
- Spend time in prayer and scripture daily
- Love the youth despite their words and actions
- Be proactive in spending time with youth, not just your "favorites"
- Be prepared to go on all youth trips
- Attend all staff meetings, read and complete all assignments on time
- Be EARLY for all youth events, stay till all of the youth are picked up and attend all church-wide events
- Must clearly discuss any potential schedule conflicts that may occur over the course of the internship including summer school and other summer commitments you may have outside of Covenant
- Know that this is where your time is going for the summer. Your time will not be on your own, unless it is an off day. We ask that you not babysit, or do other jobs during the days of the week that are work days.
